Champagne

1. Charles de Sainte Hélène Brut, *Chardonnay-Pinot Noir*, NV. £49.00
12.5%. Our house champagne. Soft nutty characteristics, dry with a honeyed richness followed by a long, delicate finish.
2. Gosset Grande Reserve, *Chardonnay- Pinot Noir-Pinot Meunier* £85.00
NV. 12%. Intense and complex. Aromatic notes mixed with flowers and fruits.
A long and powerful flavour.

Rosé

3. Gosset Grande Rosé Brut, *Chardonnay-Pinot Noir*, NV. 12%. £90.50
A fresh, lively and delicate flavour. An ideal balance between Chardonnay and Pinot Noir.

Sparkling

4. Camel Valley 'Cornwall' Brut 2013, *Seyval Blanc-Huxelrebe-Reichensteiner*. Nanstallon, Bodmin. 12.5%. A quintessential English sparkler, produced just ten miles away at Camel Valley vineyards near Bodmin. Bright and lively whilst still remaining elegantly fruity.

Rosé

5. Camel Valley Pinot Noir Rosé Brut, 2014, *Pinot Noir*. 12.5%. £55.00
A taut, creamy pink, Cornish Pinot Noir from Camel Valley. Fragrant with restrained cranberry fruit.

Prosecco

6. Mionetto Prosecco Di Valdobbiadene DOC "Spago" NV. 11% £34.00
Sublime style from one of the leading houses. An elegant aperitif.

White Wine

France

Languedoc

7. Domaine St. Félix, *Sauvignon-Vermentino*, 2015, Languedoc. £21.50
12.5%. Our house white wine. Fresh and aromatic this is a very easy drinking white with delicate fruit and a bright finish.
8. Domaine St. Hilaire, *Viognier*, 2015, Costières de Pomerols. £29.00
13.5%. A medium, full bodied wine. Aromas of ripe apricots and peaches. Flavours of melon and pear.

Alsace

9. Domaine Henry Fuchs, *Gewürztraminer*, 2014, Ribeauvillé. £27.00
13.5%. Sweet and aromatic with exotic fruit. Lovely mouthfeel with good acidity and honey on the palate. Hints of Earl Grey and lychee on the nose.

The Loire Valley

10. Muscadet de Sèvre et Maine sur Lie, *Melon de Bourgogne*, £25.95
2014, Domaine de la Tourlaudière. *12%*. Exquisitely balanced with subtle apple-like aromas, a hint of citrus and finishing with a Muscadet tingle. A great partner with seafood.
11. Pouilly Fumé, *Sauvignon Blanc*, 2015, Domaine Michel Bailly. £39.50
13%. Aromatic and complex Sauvignon, with exotic fruits, and flavours of quince and pear, with a spicy note of ginger too.
12. Sancerre, *Sauvignon Blanc*, 2014, Roger and Didier Raimbault, £46.00
Verdigny. *12.5%*. A beautifully balanced wine, bringing together ripe apples and citrus with fragrant acidity. There is a sense of minerality in the texture, with depth of flavour finishing with lively acidity.

Burgundy

13. Chablis Premier Cru, *Chardonnay*, 2014, Simmonet-Febvre, £56.00
Montmains. *13%*. Pristine concentration and complexity of flavour are the hallmarks of Simmonet-Febvre, a revered maker in Chablis. All the zippy-freshness you would expect from a high level Chablis.
14. Meursault, *Chardonnay*, 2013, Les Grand Charrons, £77.00
Michel Bouzereau. Cote de Beaune. *13.5%*. Pale golden yellow in colour. The floral and smoky nose of this Meursault wine leads onto a beautifully constructed palate with mild acidity and sustained length.

Cornwall

15. Camel Valley Bacchus Dry, *Bacchus*, 2014, Nanstallon, Bodmin £39.00
12%. A fresh, dry wine with a deliciously fruity bouquet and grapey flavour.
16. Trevibban Mill Constantine, *Chardonnay-Serval Blanc*, £39.00
2014, Padstow. 11%. From this new local vineyard, Constantine is Cornwall's answer to Chablis. With 20% of the blend aged in oak, this is an interesting and well integrated, fruit forward wine with some light vanilla and smoky notes on the finish.

Italy

17. Belfiore, *Pinot Grigio*, 2015, Vicenza. 12% £24.00
Delicate and flavoursome Giovanni Cielo's Belfiore Pinot Grigio is an authentic Northern Italian Pinot Grigio. Fresh, alpine influenced springs and mild autumns allow gentle ripening to produce a subtle, refreshing white wine.
18. Gavi di Gavi, *Cortese*, 2015, Sarotto, Piedmont. 12.5% £38.00
The Cortese grape produces fine, racy dry wines in the Piedmont region of Northern Italy. Restrained, and minerally with aromas of fresh bread, lime and toasted almond.

Spain

19. Rioja Blanco, *Viura-Malvasia*, 2015, Muga, Rioja Alta. 13% £28.50
This white rioja is traditionally straw-yellow/green in colour. The nose is powerful with aromas of pineapple and peach. The palate is fresh with well-integrated oak, pungent spicy flavours and good acidity.
20. Godello Crego e Monaguillo, *Godello-Treixadura*, 2016, 13% £34.00
A complex, dry wine which definitely rivals Albariño. Aromas of orange blossom and apples followed by an intense and beautifully balanced palate of tropical fruit with a touch of lime.

Portugal

21. 'Raza' Quinta da Raza, *Arinto-Azal*, 2015, Vinho Verde. 11.5% £23.50
A classic Vinho Verde, with some gentle spritz. Very pale, lemon-green, with a nose of white flowers and citrus. On the palate clean, crisp, refreshing, with orchard fruit flavours. A lovely summer wine.

Germany

22. Dr Loosen Estate, *Riesling*, 2014, Mosel. 8.5% £34.00
Fresh, lively wine with well-balanced fruit, flavours of pears, apples and peach with a touch of spice and attractive underlying minerality.

Austria

23. *Grüner Veltliner* LOIS, 2015, Loimer, Kamptal. 11.5% £33.00
Pale yellow in colour, this wine is aromatic and lively. Aromas of fresh apples and citrus, with spice components as well as exotic fruit and a refreshing acidity on the palate.

South Africa

24. Lyngrove, *Chenin Blanc*, 2015, Lutzville. 13% £25.50
A classic South African Chenin Blanc – a grape they've made virtually their own. Medium and flavoursome with aromas of white peach, green apple, lime and notes of tropical fruit.

25. Mulderbosch, *Sauvignon Blanc*, 2013, Stellenbosch. 13.5% £37.00
A great pioneer for quality South African Sauvignon that gives New Zealand a run for its money. Plenty of ripe fruit underpinned with crisp nettle, herbaceous notes.

New Zealand

26. Lanark Lane, *Sauvignon Blanc*, 2015, Marlborough. 12.5% £34.00
Fresh, lively gooseberry and passion fruit aromas on the nose. The palate is rich and concentrated with a beautiful, balanced finish.

27. Kim Crawford, *Sauvignon Blanc*, 2015, Marlborough. 12.5% £44.00
Benchmark Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc from this iconic producer. A mouth watering slab of crushed gooseberry and pineapple flavours.

Australia

28. Auction House, *Chardonnay*, 2016, SE Australia. 12.5% £23.50
With the move away from big oaky chardonnays this light breezy white is succulent, buttery fruit with a lemony edge.

Tasmania

29. Tamar Ridge, *Riesling*, 2010, Kayena. 12.5% £44.00
Very pale straw colour with aromas of orange blossom, lime and spice followed by a citrus end note. Lean, steely like structure with flavours of lime, citrus, spice and mineral. A crisp zesty, acid finish.

Rosé Wine

Cornwall

30. Camel Valley Rosé, *Pinot Noir-Dornfelder*, 2015, Nanstallon, £37.00
Bodmin. 13%. An elegant dry, yet fruity rosé which has a pleasing ripeness and plenty of lively red fruit flavours.
31. Trevibban Mill Rock Rosé, *Dornfelder-Rondo-Pinot Noir Precoce*, 2014, Padstow. 11%. Garnacha pink in colour, Trevibban Mill's Rock Rose has powerful aromas of fresh red fruit and pear drop. Strawberries and cherries dominate on the palette but don't let the fruit sweetness fool you, this wine is absolutely dry with a very attractive, crisp finish. £32.00

France

32. Domaine St Félix, *Grenache-Cinsault*, 2015, Languedoc. 12.5% £21.50
Our house rosé wine. Almost Provencal in style, delicate, salmon pink and heather dry.
33. Jas D'Esclans, *Cinsault-Grenache-Syrah-Carignan*, 2014, £36.50
Côtes de Provence Cru Classé. 13%
An organic estate since 1990. This pale, salmon-pink rosé has a fine, complex nose, with red berries and apricot. Exquisitely balanced, with flavours that are well defined yet delicate.

Portugal

34. Alandra, *Aragonez-Trincadeira*, 2014, Esporão. 13.5%. £24.00
Alentejo. 13%. Deep pink in colour with fresh, delicate and elegant flavours. Aromas of strawberry and raspberry.

Red Wine

France

Languedoc

35. Domaine St. Félix, *Merlot-Cabernet-Carignan*, 2015, £21.50
Languedoc. 12.5%. Our house red wine. Soft and smooth with juicy blackberry fruit and silky tannins on the finish.

Bordeaux

36. Château Tour Bigorre, *Cabernet Sauvignon-Cabernet Franc-Merlot*, 2009, Côtes de Bordeaux Castillon. 14%. A family estate passed from father to son for more than two centuries. A dark, inky wine. Dusty, earthy notes in the beginning with red fruits and some tannin. £35.50
37. Château Poujeaux, *Cabernet Sauvignon-Merlot-Cabernet Franc-Petit Verdot*, 2010, Moulis-en-Medoc. 14%. Probably the best Poujeaux since the fabulous 1982. The nose exudes black fruit and spice and the opulent, very ripe style on the palate is all present but without losing the Poujeaux elegance and precision. There are very high quality tannins here and great balance. £68.00

Burgundy

38. Beaune, *Pinot Noir*, 2013, Domaine Yves Girardin £41.00
Cote de Beaune. 13%. Penetrating aromas of soft red fruits. The tannins are well-integrated into the fruit and extract, giving excellent balance.
39. Santenay 1^{er} Cru, *Pinot Noir*, 2014, Château de la Charrière, £52.00
Cote de Beaune. 13%. A nicely spicy and gently wood-inflected Santenay 1^{er} Cru, with an appealing range of spiced red berry fruit.

Provence

40. Bandol, *Mourvèdre-Grenache*, 2005, Domaine Le Galantin. £36.50
13.5%. This is a medium-bodied, complex wine, with aromas of spice, pepper and leather, but still with fresh fruit notes, such as raspberry and blackcurrant.

Beaujolais

41. Beaujolais-Villages, *Gamay*, 2014, Domaines Nuges. 13%. £28.00
Appetising aromas of redcurrant and cherry, with succulent fruity flavours from an exceptionally concentrated year.

Italy

42. Faunus, Nero D'Avola, 2014, Sicily. 13% £28.00
Rounded, packed with black fruit flavours and with a smoky vanilla finish, this is an Italian wine to savour and enjoy.
43. Allegrini Ripasso della Valpolicella, Cortegiara £39.50
Corvina-Rondinella-Molinara, 2014, Veneto. 13.5%
Fresh red wine is literally "re-passed" over the skins of the loft dried Amarone grapes, this infuses some of the unctuous raisin flavours of Amarone – a delightful Italian delicacy.

Spain

44. Clos Mont Blanc, *Tempranillo-Cabernet Sauvignon*, 2015, £24.50
Conca de Barbera, Catalonia. 14.5%. Intense ruby red colour. Aromas of red fruits, raspberries and blackberries, and balsamic notes. The taste is sweet, elegant mix of fruit and toasted wood.
45. Rioja Crianza Lopez, *Tempranillo-Garnacha Tinta-Graciano*, £29.50
2014, Bodegas Classica, Rioja Alta. 13.5%. Soft, expressive and elegant, combining subtle toasty vanilla notes with perfectly balanced oak.

Portugal

46. Terra D'Alter, *Trincadeira-Aragonês-Syrah*, 2015, Alentejo. £26.00
14%. Intense violet colour, ripe wild fruit and plum aroma. Ripe smooth tannins in the mouth, with spices and toasted wood in the finish.

Lebanon

47. Massaya Classic, *Cinsault-Cabernet Sauvignon-Syrah*. 2013, £37.00
Bekaa Valley. 14.5%. A dark rich, plummy nose, perfumed and aromatic with the sweetness of eastern spice. Great body, well-rounded, a splash of acidity and crunch red fruits from the Cinsault

South Africa

48. Lyngrove, *Pinotage*, 2015, Stellenbosch. 14% £26.00
A very typical pinotage. Ruby red colour, crammed with ripe, dark berries and hints of spice.
49. Meerlust Rubicon, *Cabernet Sauvignon-Merlot-Cabernet Franc* £65.00
-Petit Verdot, 2008, Stellenbosch. 14%. Meerlust's Rubicon is one of the most highly rated wines in South Africa. This Bordeaux blend has a rich, intense spicy nose with a tarry edge. Concentrated, firmly tannic palate with spicy tannins and good acidity.

New Zealand

50. Felton Road, *Pinot Noir*, 2013, Bannockburn, Central Otago. £60.50
14%. Subtle layers of dark berry flavours and sweet spices here. Elegant, refreshing and balanced. A great food wine.

Australia

51. Willowglen, *Shiraz*, 2014, De Bortoli, S E Australia. 13.5% £25.50
A medium bodied shiraz with flavours of plum and blackcurrant, underlying toasty wood and a long, flavoursome finish.
52. Botham Merrill Willis, 2009, *Cabernet Sauvignon*, £46.50
Coonawarra. 14.5%. Cricket legends and fellow wine buffs Ian Botham and Bob Willis joined forces with one of Australia's top wine makers, Geoff Merrill, to launch their own range of fine wines. Deep red in colour with intense aromas. The palate is wonderfully supple and fleshy with fine firm tannins providing excellent structure.

Chile

53. Carta Vieja, *Merlot*, 2014, Loncomilla Valley. 13% £23.95
An easy drinking Chilean red. Fruity aromas and cinnamon notes. Dry with soft red fruits and a lingering finish.
54. Casas del Bosque, *Syrah*, 2014, Casablanca. 14.5% £43.00
A full bodied wine. A perfect New World expression of the "Shiraz" grape – blackberry, black olive and lifted black pepper spice. Soft and creamy texture with fine vanilla oak.

Argentina

55. Dante Robino, 2015, *Malbec*, Mendoza. 13.5% £33.00
Sweeping and broad with flat, smoky black fruit. On the palate rich and satisfyingly full-bodied

Half Bottles

Champagne

56. Charles de Sainte Hélène Brut, *Chardonnay-Pinot Noir*, NV. £29.00
12.5%. Our house champagne. Soft nutty characteristics, dry with a honeyed richness followed by a long, delicate finish.

57. Gosset Excellence Brut NV, *Chardonnay-Pinot Noir- Pinot Meunier*, Champagne. £40.50
Fresh pear, honeysuckle and vine flower aromas, slightly influenced by Pinot Noir. A balanced wine and a good flavour.

White

France

58. Chablis, Chardonnay, 2014, Domaine du Colombier, £27.00
Burgundy, *12.5%*. Ripe pear, melon, buttercream and mineral on the nose. The palate is juicy and bright with tangy fruit, grapefruit and a lightly smoky mineral tone along with a lovely saline underpinning. Lively and fresh with a snappy citrus finish.

New Zealand

59. Kim Crawford, *Sauvignon Blanc*, 2015, Marlborough. *12.5%* £22.00
Benchmark Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc from this iconic producer. A mouth watering slab of crushed gooseberry and pineapple flavours.

Red

France

60. Fleurie, *Gamay*, 2014, Domaine Chignard “ Les Moriers” £23.00
Beaujolais *12.5%*. Crunchy fruit with faint chalky and mineral flavor. Soft in the mouth with bunches of refreshing acidity.

Australia

61. Simon Hackett, *Shiraz*, 2014, Hills View, McLaren Vale, *14%*. £21.00
Flavours of black cherry, bramble, tobacco and chocolate. Bright and juicy with round tannins and an earthy finish.

Dessert Wines

France

62. Chateau d'Exindre, 2013, **Bottle (750ml)** £45.00
Muscat de Mireval Languedoc- Roussillon. **Glass (75ml)** £ 5.95
16%. This lightly honey sweet wine is made from Muscat de Petit Grains, the finest of the muscat grapes, and has a lovely balance of fruit and acidity, with a hint of Seville orange in the background.

Australia

63. Vat 5 Botrytis, *Sémillon*, 2011, **Half Bottle (375ml)** £28.50
De Bortoli Riverina. 11% **Glass (75ml)** £6.95
The baby brother of The Noble One. A beautifully honeyed dessert wine with a refreshing vein of citrus.

64. Noble One, Botrytis *Sémillon*, 2011, **Half Bottle (375ml)** £54.00
De Bortoli, Riverina. 10%.
Australia's benchmark dessert wine. First created by Darren De Bortoli at the family winery in Bilbul in 1982, Noble One has gone on to be one of the most awarded wines in history. Bright yellow-gold, aromas of nectarine and peach with citrus hints and sweet vanillin oak. A richly opulent palate of dried stone fruits, citrus and honey complexed by oak.

California

65. Elysium, *Black Muscat*, 2014, Madera **Half Bottle (375ml)** £35.00
15% Deep ruby red in colour this black **Glass (75ml)** £8.95
muscat is exquisitely syrupy with brambly aroma and wild sweetness.
