Champagne

1. Charles de Sainte Hélène Brut, *Chardonnay-Pinot Noir-Pinot Meunier*, NV, Maurice Delabaye et Fils. 12.5%. Our house champagne. Soft nutty characteristics, dry with a honeyed richness followed by a long, delicate finish. £68.00
2. Gosset Grande Réserve, *Chardonnay- Pinot Noir-Pinot Meunier* NV. 12%. The tiny bubbles and biscuity aroma of this wonderfully smooth champagne make it iconic. It has a beautiful light gold colour, sweet aromas of nuts and pears, with a remarkable finish. £110.00

Rosé

3. Gosset Grande Rosé Brut, *Chardonnay-Pinot Noir*, NV. 12%. £120.00
Delicate salmon pink in colour with rich red fruits on the palate. A superb finish on account of the lively acidity.

Cornwall

4. Knightor Brut Classic Cuvée, *Reichensteiner-Chardonnay-Huxelrebe -Kerner-Pinot Noir-Pinot Gris-Seyval Blanc*, NV. St Austell. 11%. £70.00
A fresh, floral and fruity wine with honeysuckle, pear and white peach flavours. A delicate fine mousse on the palate with a dry and crisp finish.

Rosé

5. La Guilloterie, *Cabernet Franc*, NV, *Crémant de Loire, France*. £57.00
12.5%. Peachy pink colour, sweet notes of red fruits and bread crust on the nose. Creamy, fruity and soft in the mouth.

Prosecco

6. Prosecco Spumante Porte Nova, *Glera*, NV, Veneto. 11% £36.00
Pale light yellow in colour with a delicately fruity, slightly aromatic bouquet. On the palate hints of honey and apple.

White Wine

France

Languedoc-Roussillon

7. Domaine St. Félix, *Sauvignon-Vermentino*, 2022, Pays d'Hérault. £30.00
12.5%. Our house white wine. Fresh and aromatic this is a very easy drinking white with delicate fruit and a bright finish.

8. Domaine St. Hilaire, *Expression, Viognier*, 2021, Pays d'Oc. £36.00
13.5%. A medium, full-bodied wine. Aromas of ripe apricots and peaches. Flavours of melon and pear.

Alsace

9. Domaine Henry Fuchs, *Gewürztraminer*, 2019, Ribeauvillé. £45.00
13.5%. Hints of Earl Grey and lychee on the nose. Off dry and aromatic with exotic fruit. Lovely mouthfeel with good acidity and honey on the palate.

The Loire Valley

10. Muscadet de Sèvre et Maine sur Lie, *Melon de Bourgogne*, £35.00
2022, Domaine de la Tourlaudière. 12%. Exquisitely balanced with subtle apple-like aromas, a hint of citrus and finishing with a Muscadet tingle. A great partner with seafood.

11. Pouilly Fumé, *Sauvignon Blanc*, 2021, Domaine Nicolas Gaudry £49.50
12.5%. A zesty, honeyed nose, with delicate, floral notes. Dry, with good tension and intense, long flavours.

12. Sancerre, *Sauvignon Blanc*, 2022, Domaine Tassin, £56.00
Domaine de la Tonnellerie. 13%. Dry, crisp and elegant. Unoaked, the palate is rich in fruit flavours and finishes with the right balance of texture and refreshing acidity.

Burgundy

13. Saint Aubin 1er Cru, *Chardonnay*, 2020, 'Sous Roche Dumay', £78.00
Domaine Larue. 13%. Buttery and complex, with a rounded mouthfeel. Rich, intense and perfectly judged oak.

14. Meursault, *Chardonnay*, 2018, Domaine Paul Garaudet, £95.00
Cote de Beaune. 13%. A truly remarkable Meursault. Full of rich layers of buttery fruit, underlying mineral roundness and texture with an amazingly long persistent finish.

Cornwall

16. Knightor *Madeleine Angevine-Bacchus- Reichensteiner* £45.00
-*Seyval Blanc*, 2021, Trethurgy, St. Austell. 11.5%. A crisp and delicate wine with flavours of apple and citrus. Think a British version of a *Vino Verde*.

Italy

17. Ornato Terre Siciliane, *Pinot Grigio*, 2022, Vicenza. 12% £32.00
Classic Italian *Pinot Grigio*. Dry with refreshing and balanced acidity. Perfect with any fish dish.
18. Gavi di Gavi, La Giustiniana, *Cortese*, 2022, Piedmont. 13% £48.50
The *Cortese* grape produces fine, racy dry wines in the Piedmont region of Northern Italy. Restrained, and minerally with aromas of fresh bread, lime and toasted almond.

Spain

19. Rioja Blanco, *Viura-Malvasia*, 2022, Muga, Rioja Alta. 13.5%. £43.50
The nose is powerful with aromas of pineapple and peach. The palate is fresh with well-integrated oak, pungent spicy flavours and good acidity.
20. *Godello*, 2021, Benito Santos, Ladeira de Monterrei. 13%. £55.00
Pale straw with a hint of green. A fresh nose with aromas of white flowers and tropical fruits. On the palate, there are flavours of apricot, green apple and a touch of mango leading to a long, subtle finish.

Portugal

21. 'Raza' Quinta da Raza, *Arinto-Azal*, 2022, Vinho Verde. 11.5% £30.50
A classic *Vinho Verde*, with some gentle spritz. Very pale, lemon-green, with a nose of white flowers and citrus. On the palate clean, crisp, refreshing, with orchard fruit flavours. A lovely summer wine.

Germany

22. Dr Loosen Estate, *Riesling*, 2021, Mosel. 8.5%. £36.00
Fresh, lively wine with well-balanced fruit, flavours of pears, apples and peach with a touch of spice and attractive underlying minerality.

Hungary

23. *Grüner Veltliner*, Torley Talisman, 2021, Tokay. 12.5%. £30.50
From vineyards of Ethel-Buda, Torley is an innovative wine yard at the forefront of Hungarian wine making. Clean and dry with flavours of fresh pears.

South Africa

24. Freedom Cross, *Chenin Blanc*, 2021, Franschoek Cellar. 12.5% £33.00
Western Cape. A classic South African Chenin Blanc – a grape they've made virtually their own. Succulent flavours of tropical fruit dominate this crisp, zesty wine.
25. Babylonstoren Candide, *Chenin Blanc-Viognier-Chardonnay-Sémillon*. 2021, Simonsberg, Stellenbosch. 13.5%. This intriguing white blend expresses a fresh, fruit-driven wine with peach, lime and litchi flavours. Light and refreshing yet complex.
26. Paul Cluver, *Chardonnay*, 2018, Elgin, Western Cape. 13.5% £60.00
A beautiful cool climate Chardonnay. This Elgin classic is 30% new oak fermented and matured but the oak is very subtle. Mineral, textured, ripe fruit but plenty of acidity. A hint of honey, vanilla, stone fruit and fragrant citrus.

New Zealand

27. Kim Crawford, *Sauvignon Blanc*, 2022, Marlborough. 13% £48.00
Benchmark Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc from this iconic producer. A mouth watering slab of crushed gooseberry and pineapple flavours.

Australia

28. Whistling Duck, *Chardonnay*, 2022, New South Wales. 12.5% £33.00
With the move away from big oaky chardonnays this light breezy white is succulent, buttery fruit with a lemony edge.
29. One Chain 'The Courtisan', *Riesling*, 2021, Wild and Wilder, £40.00
Clare Valley. 12%. Extravagantly perfumed nose and beautiful frame corseted by mouthwatering fruit. A lime citrus tang with grapefruit and quince followed by a long dry finish.

Lebanon

30. Massaya Classic White, *Obeïdi.-Rolle-Clairette-Sauvignon Blanc-Chardonnay*. 2020. Bekaa Valley. 13%. White flower, lemon, and a touch of nectarine. It combines depth, roundness, crispness, and an oriental twinkle thanks to the local obeïdi.

Rosé Wine

Cornwall

31. Knightor Carpe Diem, *Rondo-Dornfelder- Schönberger-
-Siegerrebe-Pinot Noir*, 11%. This rosé has a delicate salmon pink hue. Fresh,
delicate and fruity, with aromas of rose petal, raspberry, peach and strawberry. £45.50

France

32. Domaine St Félix, *Grenache-Cinsault*, 2021, Languedoc-
Roussillon. 12.5%. Our house rosé wine. Almost Provencal in style, delicate, salmon
pink and heather dry. £30.00
33. Gamali, *Grenache-Cinsault*, 2022, Domaine la Goujonne, £44.00
Côtes de Provence. 13.5% (Organic)
Delicious nose of red, summer fruits with a hint of zesty grapefruit. Soft and fruity but
with good supporting acidity and flavour intensity, with a hint of fig.

Spain

34. Borsao Rosado, *Garnacha*, 2021, Campo de Borja. 13.5%. £32.00
Strawberry pink in colour, crisp and packed with ripe, red fruits. Easy drinking in
style showcasing more fruit flavours than the paler style rosés.

Red Wine

France

Languedoc-Roussillon

35. Domaine St. Félix, *Merlot-Cabernet-Carignan*, 2020, £30.00
Pays d'Hérault. 12.5%. Our house red wine. Soft and smooth with juicy blackberry fruit and silky tannins on the finish.

Bordeaux

36. Château Tour Bigorre, *Cabernet Sauvignon-Cabernet Franc-Merlot*, 2014, Côtes de Bordeaux Castillon. 13.5%. £47.00
A family estate passed from father to son for more than two centuries. A dark, inky wine. Dusty, earthy notes in the beginning with red fruits and some tannin.
37. Château Grand Tayac, 2019, Cabernet Sauvignon -*Merlot-Petit Verdot, Alain Roses, Margaux*. 13%. £88.00
Ripe blackberry, plum, black cherry and spices on the nose. Strong tannins, medium to full body and black fruits, tobacco and vanilla on the palate.

Burgundy

38. Beaune, *Pinot Noir*, 2021, Domaine Yves Girardin £58.00
Côte de Beaune. 13%. Penetrating aromas of soft red fruits. The tannins are well-integrated into the fruit and extract, giving excellent balance.
39. Santenay 1^{er} Cru, *Pinot Noir*, 2020, 'La Maladière', Domaine £70.00
Yves Girardin, Côte de Beaune. 13%. A nicely spicy and gently wood-inflected Santenay 1er Cru, with an appealing range of spiced red berry fruit.

Provence

40. Bandol, *Mourvèdre-Cinsault-Syrah*, 2017, Domaine Bunan. £43.00
Moulindes Costes .14.5%. Complex, with aromas of spice, pepper and leather, but still with fresh fruit notes, such as raspberry and blackcurrant.

Beaujolais

41. Beaujolais-Villages, *Gamay*, 2020, Domaine de la Rizolier. 13%. £38.50
Appetising aromas of redcurrant and cherry, with succulent fruity flavours. A light bodied red, suitable with white meat and fish.

Côtes du Rhône Villages

42. Sablet, *Grenache-Syrah*, 2020, Domaine Notre Dame des £43.00
Pallieres. 14%. Beautiful bright purple colour, with a nose of fresh, intense fruit and notes of Morello cherry and blackberry. The palate is fleshy, crunchy, full of fruit with weight and silky tannins.

Italy

43. Passimiento, *Nero d'Avola - Frapatto*, 2021, Baglio Gibellina £46.00
13.5% Bright intense red fruit on the nose displaying lots of red berries. Warm and full bodied on the palate, with balanced acidity and smooth, elegant tannins.
44. Valpolicella Superiore, *Corvina-Rondinella-Sangiovese*, £52.50
2020, Veneto. 13.5%. A beautifully smooth and velvety wine with great depth of flavour. The nose offers supple fragrances of almonds and violets. Crisp, dry and well-structured in the mouth.

Spain

45. Clos Mont Blanc, *Tempranillo-Cabernet Sauvignon*, 2021, £32.00
Conca de Barbera, Catalonia. 13.5%. Intense ruby red colour. Aromas of red fruits, raspberries and blackberries, and balsamic notes. The taste is sweet, elegant mix of fruit and toasted wood.
46. Rioja Crianza Lopez, *Tempranillo-Garnacha Tinta-Graciano*, £43.00
2019, Bodegas Classica, Rioja Alta. 13.5%. Soft, expressive and elegant, combining subtle toasty vanilla notes with perfectly balanced oak.

Portugal

47. Altano, *Touriga Franca-Tinta Roriz-Tinta Barroca*, 2020, £36.50
Symington Family Estates, Douro Valley. 14%. Generous aromas of wildflowers. Full bodied structure with fresh, assertive fruit and spicy notes.

Israel

48. Har'el, *Merlot*, 2020, Clos de Gat, Judaen Hills. 13.5%. £70.00 .
Powerful aromas of blackberries & plums, which are enhanced by notes of earthy Mediterranean terroir. On the palate, the wine is rounded and full bodied, tannins smooth and already integrated with a long finish. A beautifully soft wine.

South Africa

49. Freedom Cross, *Pinotage*, 2019, Franschoek Cellars. 13.5% £34.00
Western Cape. A softly styled pinotage with intense blackberry fruit and mocha coffee notes.
50. Babylonstoren Babel, *Shiraz-Cabernet Sauvignon-Malbec* £45.00
-Merlot-Cabernet Franc-Petit Verdot, 2020, Simonsberg, Paarl. 14%. *This full-bodied wine is a fusion of red berry and chocolate flavours with a chewy mouthfeel and juicy, lingering finish.*
51. Babylonstoren Nebukadnesar, *Cabernet Sauvignon-Merlot* 70.00
Cabernet Franc-Petit Verdot-Malbec 2019, Simonsberg, Paarl. 14.5%. The flagship wine of Babylonstoren. Opens with an elegant nose of red berries, violets, brambles and cigar. Layers of earthy, smoky dark fruit on the palette.

New Zealand

52. Greywacke, *Pinot Noir*, 2019, Marlborough, 13.5% £75.00
A beautifully balanced wine. Perfumed nose of cherry and wild fruits leads to a beautifully balanced palate with pure fruit, a subtle herb character and a kiss of smoky oak.

Australia

53. Whistling Duck, *Shiraz*, 2021, New South Wales. 13.5% £33.00
Rich flavours of ripe plums, dark cherries and fresh blackberries with a lovely hint of spice.
54. Bird in Hand, *Cabernet Sauvignon*, 2019, Adelaide Hills. 13.5%. £62.50
This medium bodied wine is an intensely complex, yet varietal cabernet, with blackcurrant, plum and violet florals complemented by oak characters.

Chile

55. Cornellana, *Cabernet-Merlot*, 2022, Cachapoal Valley. 13.5% £33.00
A well-structured approachable red, medium bodied with plummy, curranty fruit. The Cabernet gives superb depth and structure to the fleshy Merlot. From an area that is producing some of the best Chilean wines.

Argentina

56. Gougenheim, *Malbec*, 2022, Mendoza. 13.5% £37.50
Aromas of black raspberry and currants with a hint of toasty vanilla. This full-bodied, well-structured wine has plenty of fine, velvety tannins.

USA

57. Edmeades, *Zinfandel-Petite Syrah-Syrah*, 2018, Mendocino, California. 15.5%. £62.50
Bold and intense on the palate with soft tannins and rich flavours of spice, blackberry jam, chocolate and some cedar notes.

Champagne

58. Charles de Sainte Hélène Brut, *Chardonnay-Pinot Noir-Pinot Meunier*. NV. 12.5%. Our house champagne. Soft nutty characteristics, dry with a honeyed richness followed by a long, delicate finish. £37.50
59. Gosset Excellence Brut NV, *Chardonnay-Pinot Noir- Pinot Meunier*, Champagne. Fresh pear, honeysuckle and vine flower aromas, slightly influenced by Pinot Noir. A balanced wine and a good flavour. £50.00

White

France

60. Pouilly Fumé, *Sauvignon Blanc*, 2021, Domaine Nicolas Gaudry. 12.5%. A zesty, honeyed nose, with delicate, floral notes. Dry, with good tension and intense, long flavours. £27.00

Red

France

61. Brouilly, *Gamay*, 2020, Château du Pavé, Brac de la Perrière. 13%. The dominant fruit on the palate is black cherry, with a touch of cassis and raspberry. A wine that finishes long. £25.00

Dessert Wines

France

60. Monbazillac, 2018, *Sauvignon Blanc*, **Bottle (375ml)** £26.50
Château Grambois. 15% **Glass(70ml)** £6.95
Copper/orange in colour with a ripe, grapey aromas with a twist of orange blossom. Rich in the mouth, soft and silky with flavours of apricot.

Australia

61. Vat 5 Botrytis, *Sémillon*, 2018, **Bottle (375ml)** £32.00
De Bortoli Riverina. *11%* **Glass (70ml)** £7.25
The baby brother of The Noble One. A beautifully honeyed dessert wine with a refreshing vein of citrus.

California

62. Elysium, *Black Muscat*, 2018, Madera. *15%* **Bottle (375ml)** £40.00
Glass (70ml) £9.25
Deep ruby red in colour this black muscat is exquisitely syrupy with brambly aroma and wild sweetness. Great with chocolate.

South Africa

63. Late Harvest Noble, *Riesling*, 2020, **Bottle (375ml)** £46.00
Paul Cluver Estate, Elgin **Glass (70ml)** £10.50
12%. Paul Cluver's Noble Riesling is the best of its kind in South Africa. Dried apricot, spices and honey characters on the nose. The mouth feel is full and big and very balanced with a long lingering aftertaste.

Uruguay

64. Alcyone, *Tannat*, 2020, Bodega Pablo Fallabrino **Bottle (500ml)** £58.50
Canelones. *16%* **Glass (70ml)** £9.50
Radiant purple hue and honey like texture. The base wine was aged for several years in French oak barrels. This wine is aromatised with several roots and herbs, with flavours of black cherry and tonka bean.
