# Champagne

- 1. Charles de Sainte Hélène Brut / Chardonnay-Pinot Noir-Pinot £76.00 Meunier / NV / Maurice Delabaye et Fils /12.5% / Our house champagne. Soft nutty characteristics, dry with a honeyed richness followed by a long, delicate finish.
- 2. Gosset Grande Réserve / Chardonnay- Pinot Noir-Pinot Meunier £130.00 NV /12% / The tiny bubbles and biscuity aroma of this wonderfully smooth champagne make it iconic. It has a beautiful light gold colour, sweet aromas of nuts and pears, with a remarkable finish.

## Rosé

3. Gosset Grande Rosé Brut / Chardonnay-Pinot Noir / NV / 12% £160.00 Delicate salmon pink in colour with rich red fruits on the palate. A superb finish on account of the lively acidity.

# Sparkling

- 4. Prosecco Spumante Porte Nova / *Glera* / NV / Veneto / *11%* £38.00 Pale light yellow in colour with a delicately fruity, slightly aromatic bouquet. On the palate hints of honey and apple.
- 5. Camel Valley Cornwall Brut / Seyval Blanc-Pinot Blanc-Chardonnay / 2021 / Cornwall / 12.5% / A fresh and fruity traditional method sparkling wine from Camel Valley.

6. La Guilloterie / Cabernet Franc / NV / Crémant de Loire / France £48.00 12.5% / An exceptional pink crémant. Peachy pink colour, sweet notes of red fruits and bread crust on the nose. Creamy, fruity and soft in the mouth.

# White Wine

# Cornwall

 Atlantic Dry / Pinot Blanc-Bacchus / 2023 / Camel Valley / £50.00 Bodmin / Cornwall / 12.5%. Delicate aromas of grapefruit, elderflower and green fruit. Bright lemon in colour, with a very fresh, clean finish.

# France

- 8. Domaine St. Félix / Sauvignon-Rolle / 2023 / Pays d'Hérault / £32.00 Languedoc-Roussillon / 12.5% / Our house white wine. Fresh and aromatic this is a very easy drinking white with delicate fruit and a bright finish.
- 9. Cicada / Grenahe Blanc-Viognier-Picpoul / 2023 / Domaine £34.00 Chante Cigale /13% / Made using stainless steel tanks; fruit driven with apricot and juicy melon flavours, accented with floral notes and lemony acidity.
- 10. Muscadet de Sèvre et Maine sur Lie / *Melon de Bourgogne*, / £36.50 2022 / Domaine des Raillères / The Loire Valley / 12% / White floral and citrus aromas, with flavours of fresh pear and green apple. A great partner with seafood.
- 11. Sancerre / Sauvignon Blanc / 2022 / Domaine Tassin / £56.00 The Loire Valley / 13% / The palate is rich in fruit flavours and finishes with the right balance of texture and refreshing acidity.
- 12. Pouilly-Fuissé / Chardonnay / 2022 / Les Grands Crus Blanc / £75.00 Mâconnais / Burgundy /14% / Citrus and apricot aromas mingle with violet, and on the palate you will find the rich, butteriness of Chardonnay together with subtle notes of lime flower, honey and exotic fruits.
- 13. Domaine Edmond Cornu & Fils / Meursault / Chardonnay / £110.00 2020 / Côte de Beaune / Burgundy / 13% / Full-bodied, rich, creamy with aromatic complexity. Taste intense and persistent, combining firmness and mellowness. A wonderful Meursault.

# Italy

- 14. Villa Belvedere / *Pinot Grigio* / 2023 / Friuli / *12%* £35.00 Notes of pear and white flowers with citrus vibrancy. Excellent depth of flavour with a clean, crisp finish.
- 15. Gavi di Gavi / La Giustiniana / *Cortese* / 2023 / Piedmont / 13% £58.00 The Cortese grape produces fine, racy dry wines in the Piedmont region of Northern Italy. Restrained, and minerally with aromas of fresh bread, lime and toasted almond.

## Germany

16. Dr Loosen 'L' / *Riesling* / 2022 / Mosel / 8.5%. £36.00 Fresh, lively wine with well-balanced fruit, flavours of pears, apples and peach with a touch of spice and attractive underlying minerality.

# Portugal

17. Semente / *Alvarinho* / 2023 / Vinho Verde / *13%* £45.00 Intense aromas on the nose of citrus fruits, nectarines and honeysuckle. The palate is vibrant, showing a refreshing acidity with ripe flavours of fleshy white peach and lime.

# Greece

18. Little Ark / Assyrtiko-Malagouzia / 2023 / Peloponnese / 13% £50.00 Brilliant straw colour with greenish shades. Notes of melon and jasmine with orange on the nose. The mouth is rich with flavours of peach, green apple and a lemony fresh finish

# Hungary

19. MÁD / *Furmint* / 2018 / Tokaji / *12%*. £52.00 Elegant, delicately aromatic with a touch of spice. Apricot, lychee, honeysuckle and ginger. Well-balanced with minerality and structure. Bright, mouthwatering acidity.

# South Africa

20. Babylonstoren Candide / Chenin Blanc-Viognier-Chardonnay-Sémillon / 2023 / Simonsberg / Stellenbosch / 13.5% / This intriguing white blend expresses a fresh, fruit-driven wine with peach, lime and litchi flavours. Light and refreshing, yet complex.

# New Zealand

21. Green-Lip / Sauvignon Blanc / 2022 / Jackson Estate / £52.00 Marlborough / 13% / Named after the native New Zealand green-lip mussel, the wine demonstrates tropical fruit flavours, balanced with fine minerality, followed by an expressive finish. Jackson Estate is a neighbour to Cloudy Bay vineyards.

# Australia

22. Whistling Duck / *Chardonnay* / 2024 / New South Wales / *12.5%* £34.00 With the move away from big oaky chardonnays this light breezy white is succulent, buttery fruit with a lemony edge.

# Lebanon

23. Massaya / Classic White / *Obeïdi.-Rolle-Clairette-Sauvignon Blanc-* £63.00 *Chardonnay* / 2021 / Bekaa Valley / 13% / White flower, lemon, and a touch of nectarine. It combines depth, roundness, crispness, and an oriental twinkle thanks to the local obeïdi.

# **Rosé Wine**

# Cornwall

24. Camel Valley / Pinot Noir / 2023 / Bodmin / Cornwall /12% £51.50 Fresh, delicate and fruity, with aromas of raspberry and strawberry. A beautifully balanced wine.

# France

- 25. Domaine St Félix / *Grenache-Cinsault* / 2023 / Languedoc- £32.00 Roussillon / 12.5% / Our house rosé wine. Almost Provencal in style, delicate, salmon pink and heather dry.
- 26. Gamali / *Grenache-Cinsault* / 2023 / Domaine la Goujonne / £50.00 Côtes de Provence / 13.5% Delicious nose of red, summer fruits with a hint of zesty grapefruit. Soft and fruity but with good supporting acidity and flavour intensity, with a hint of fig.

# Spain

27. Mesta / *Tempranillo* / 2023 / Central Castile / 11.5% 233.00 Strawberry pink in colour with fruity, floral flavours. Slightly off-dry finish balanced by a crisp acidity and a refreshing note.

# **Red Wine**

# France

- 28. Domaine St. Félix / *Merlot-Cabernet-Carignan* / 2022 / £32.00 Pays d'Hérault / Languedoc-Roussillon / 12.5% / Our house red wine. Soft and smooth with juicy blackberry fruit and silky tannins on the finish.
- 29. Pommard / Pinot Noir / 2005 / Chateau de la Charriere / £110.00 Domaine Yves Girardin / Côte de Beaune / Burgundy / 13.5% / From the extraordinary vintage of 2005, this Pommard retains the firmish tannins typical of the appellation, as well as the freshness and red fruit flavours that Pinot Noir is known for. A delicate touch of oak gives added depth.
- 30. Rully / *Pinot Noir* / 2022 / Domaine Jacques Dury / 'Montmorin' £71.00 13% / Red fruit nose, crisp cherry over deeper strawberry notes. The palate is crisp and fresh with crunchy fruit and fine tannins. Very well balanced and judged, this is a super mid-weight wine.
- 31. Beaujolais-Villages / *Gamay* / 2022 / Domaine de la Rizolière / £42.00 13% / Appetising aromas of redcurrant and cherry, with succulent fruity flavours. A light bodied red, suitable with white meat and fish.
- 32. Sablet / *Grenache-Syrah* / 2021 / Domaine Notre Dame des £45.00 Pallières / Côtes du Rhône Villages /14% / Beautiful bright purple colour, with a nose of fresh, intense fruit and notes of Morello cherry and blackberry. The palate is fleshy, crunchy, full of fruit with weight and silky tannins.
- 33. Domaine Huber & Bléger / *Pinot Noir* / 2021 / Rouge de Saint-Hippolyte / Alsace /13.5% / With an appetising aroma of soft, red fruits, this Alsace red is light but full of flavour. The tannins are fine-textured and it has delicious, clean Pinot Noir flavours.
- 34. Domaine de la Roche Honneur / *Cabernet Franc* / 2022 / Chinon / £46.00 Loire /12.5% / An unoaked Chinon with youthful, wild-berry fruit, herbal notes, chalky tannins and a refreshing Cabernet Franc tang on the long finish

# Italy

35. Zenato Valpolicella Superiore / *Corvina-Rondinella-Sangiovese* / £64.50 2021 / Veneto / *13.5%* / A beautifully smooth and velvety wine with great depth of flavour. The nose offers supple fragrances of almonds and violets. Flavours of black cherry and prune.

# Spain

36. Rioja Crianza / Lopez de Haro / *Tempranillo-Garnacha Tinta-* £45.00 *Graciano* / 2021 / Rioja Alta / 13.5% / Soft, expressive and elegant, combining subtle toasty vanilla notes with perfectly balanced oak.

# Portugal

37. Altano / *Touriga Franca-Tinta Roriz-Tinta Barroca* / 2021 / £36.50 Symington Family Estates / Douro Valley / 13.5% / Generous aromas of wildflowers. Full bodied structure with fresh, assertive fruit and spicy notes.

# Lebanon

38. Massaya / 'Le Colombier' / Grenache-Syrah-Tempranillo / 2021 / £53.00 Bekaa Valley /14% / Spicy notes with ripe blackberry and red fruits, and a touch of chocolate. This supple, round wine is from an exciting French-Lebanese collaboration, which owns vineyards at an altitude of 1,000 metres in the Bekaa Valley.

# South Africa

- 39. Freedom Cross / *Pinotage* / 2021 / Franschhoek Cellars / *13.5%* £36.00 Western Cape / A softly styled pinotage with intense blackberry fruit and mocha coffee notes.
- 40. Babylonstoren / Shiraz / 2022 / Simonsberg / Paarl /14% £53.50 This full-bodied wine is a fusion of cherry fruit, soft prunes and spice, with a chewy mouthfeel and juicy, lingering finish.

# New Zealand

41. Greywacke / *Pinot Noir* / 2021 / Malborough / *13.5%*. £80.00 A beautifully balanced wine. Perfumed nose of cherry and wild fruits leads to a beautifully balanced palate with pure fruit, a subtle herb character and a kiss of smoky oak.

# Chile

42. Cornellana / Cabernet-*Merlot* / 2023 / Cachapoal Valley /13.5% £33.00 A well-structured approachable red, medium bodied with plummy, curranty fruit. The Cabernet gives superb depth and structure to the fleshy Merlot. From an area that is producing some of the best Chilean wines.

# Argentina

43. Saurus Select / *Malbec* / 2022 / Patagonia / 14% £48.00 Patagonia is the most Southerly, and therefor coolest, wine growing region in Argentina. It produces a wine with much more elegance and refinement than the bigger and bolder wines of Mendoza. This Malbec has a deep hue with flavours of red cherry and currant on the palate complimented by dark chocolate and vanilla from the oak.

# Champagne

44. Charles de Sainte Hélène Brut, *Chardonnay-Pinot Noir-* £42.00 *Pinot Meunier*. NV. 12.5%. Our house champagne. Soft nutty characteristics, dry with a honeyed richness followed by a long, delicate finish.

## White

#### France

45. Chablis / 'Les Senties' / *Chardonnay* / 2020 / Famille Ternynch £35.00 Burgundy / France / 13% / Aromas of fresh flowers and citrus. Clean, crisp, and elegant, with white fruit and mineral flavours.

#### New Zealand

46. Kim Crawford / Sauvignon Blanc / 2022 / Marlborough / 13% £31.50 A benchmark Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc from this iconic producer. A mouth watering slab of crushed gooseberry and pineapple flavours.

# Red

### France

**47.** Chateau La Tour de By / Cabernet Sauvignon-Merlot-Cabernet Franc / 2019 / Cru Bourgeois Superieure / Medoc / 14% / Classic dark plum and cherries on the nose with well-integrated tannins on the palate, a big concentrated mouthful of rich summer berries and a finely-tuned finish.

#### Spain

48. Rioja Crianza / Cune / Tempranillo-Garnacha-Mazuel / £23.00 2021 / Deep, complex toasty nose, with plum, damson, coffee tones and vanilla on the palate, which is full and rounded.
